Letter of Compliance

Dear Customer,

The Consumer Product Safety Improvement Act (CPSIA) was passed by Congress in August 2008. The regulations state certain limitations regarding levels of lead, flammability, and the presence of phthalates. The CPSIA requires manufactures and importers to certify that the products they offer meet all applicable standards, and specifies that certain tests be performed in order to assure compliance.

It should be noted that the Consumer Product Safety Commission has stated that inventory manufactured prior to November 12, 2008 is not subject to the new certification requirements of CPSIA.

In accordance with Section 14 of the Consumer Product Safety Act, 15 U.S.C. 2063(a), Anagram International certifies that based upon a test or a reasonable test program, the products we sell comply with all applicable consumer product safety rules, bans, regulations or standards under the Consumer Product Safety Improvement Act (CPSIA) of 2008 or any other Act enforceable by the United States Consumer Product Safety Commission.
